Prioritized Action Items

1. Definition and use case for common data attributes (GUDID and GDSN):
(How they differ, alignment, publication instruction review, examples)
2. Critical and common data attributes to quickly publish for all:
(<10 key attribute for POU consumption)

1. Bar Code Point of Care LUC - AHRMM:
(Type, placement, easy ID, multiple barcodes vs. one, gaps where no bar code exists)
2. Feedback process for failing barcodes:
(Mobile app pilot data, other mechanisms, product complaint process, UDI Contact)

1. White paper - Define business case for use of UDI and GLN in supply chain transactions.
(Use cases, ROI for suppliers/providers, benefit to recalls, etc.)
2. Pilot

HTG Additional Actions – Next Phase

Point of Use

Data Quality Team

Verification process and feedback loop to validate data:

- 30 day review to release, mobile, or other process
- supplier feedback mechanism
- Governance

Education and Communication:

- AHRMM – Provider adoption, mentor program
- Publication instructions

Consumption Team

Education and collaboration – Barcode scanning configuration (Hardware/Software)

- Parsing of data (recognition, etc.)
- “How To” instructions for providers

Education of Supplier Reps and Customer Service:

- Understanding of barcodes on packages, GS1/GTIN terminology, etc.

High to Low categorization:

- Priority to enable scanning (e.g. implants vs. rolls of tape, etc.)

Transaction Team

Roadmap for transaction adoption:

- 850 more important than 856?
- Easier to adopt?

Funding to fully adopt UDI (updates to systems, etc.)

- Call to providers to validate GLN's
- First steps
