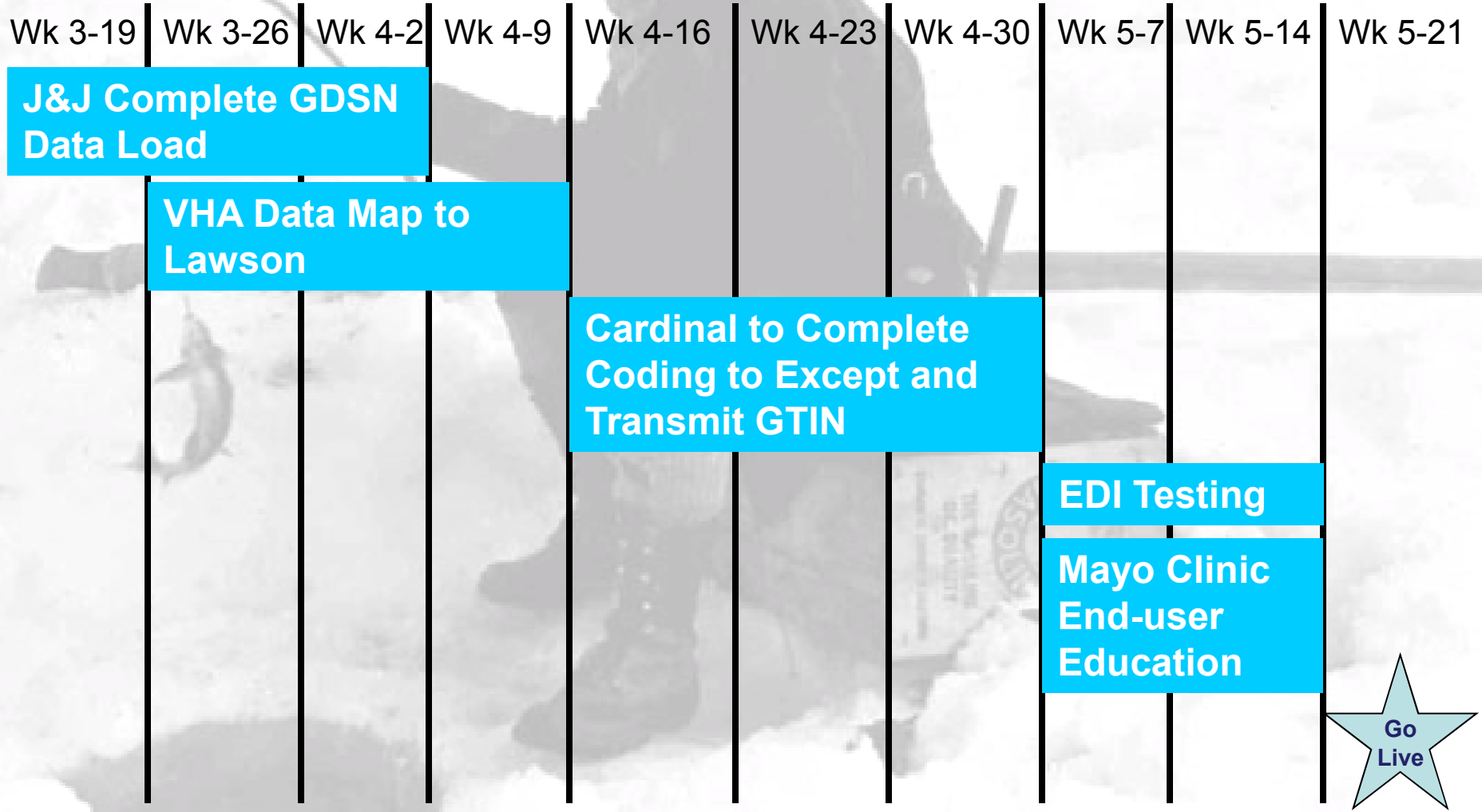

- System enhancements
 - Mayo's ERP complete March 2012
 - Cardinal ERP complete February 2012


Challenges

- System upgrades
 - Variable time line between partners
- Applications include data elements - not integrated
 - Cannot be used to drive decisions or transactions
 - Requires extensive customization
- Understanding GDSN data element requirements
 - Will requirements be unique to each partnership?
- GDSN data distribution model
 - Interpretation of “data provider” – does this imply where customers may order product
 - Identification of GDSN data elements in manufacturers system
 - Changing data elements between manufacturer and distributors
 - Especially applies to sellable unit
